## <u> English: Reading:</u>

Writing: The children will use the short story 'The Nightmare Man' to improve their use of a range of punctuation and ability to create atmosphere. They will also complete instructional writing based on 'How to train your House Goblin'. Our class novel will be 'Street Child'.

Humanities (History) Our focus this half term will be on The Victorians. The children will learn about the effects of the Industrial Revolution on the lives of working children and they will find out about some of the major achievements of the Victorian Age.

**PE:** The focus this half term is on hockey and rugby skills. Please help us to maintain our high expectations by making sure your child always comes to school dressed in the correct PE kit (white T-Shirt, black shorts/leggings/ jogging bottoms, black pumps/ trainers) on their allotted PE day.

#### Science:
