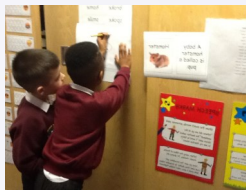
From Monday 5th November, we will require **one week's notice** when changing meal arrangements.

If an emergency meal is required, you **MUST** inform the office by 9.10am on the day with payment made **WITHIN 24 HOURS.**

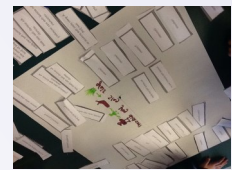
Year 2 Offspring Hunt

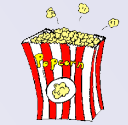

Polite Reminders

School starts at 8:55—Our gates open at 8:30, please don't leave children unsupervised on site.

Children need to arrive to class rooms promptly at 8:55 ready for 9am registration. Doors close at 9am and anyone arriving after this time must be signed in at the main office. This is to enable us to make sure that gates are then closed and locked as quickly after 9pm as possible. Thank you for your support.

School uniform: Please ensure that children wear our school colours- any pinafores or gingham dresses need to be in **Blue/ Purple**. There has been an increase in the 'variety' of colours being worn in recent weeks.

Trousers/ skirts/ pinafores are to be black or grey. Polo shirts or shirts are white / light blue with our burgundy jumper which does not have to be a logo jumper / cardigan. School shoes **MUST** be black, suitable for all weathers and without large heels or flashing lights.

Jewelry: Only small stud earrings are to be worn and must not be worn on PE or swimming days. A watch (which does not make noises or shine lights) may also be worn.

Hair: Hair which is collar length or longer should be tidied back.
