School Meals

Little Heaton C of E is responsible for the collection and reconciliation of all school dinner money and is liable for all arrears and non-payments. Parents of children in Key Stage 2 (Years 3,4,5, and 6) are responsible for providing a lunch for their child(ren); this may be in the form of a paid meal, application of a free meal entitlement or a packed lunch from home. Parents must pay for school meals **IN ADVANCE** unless their child(ren) have a free school meal entitlement. School will carry application forms for free school meals and will be happy to assist parents with applications. Should you wish to change your current school meal arrangements, **you must inform the school office at least one week in advance** and complete an amendment form (available from the office) confirming new arrangements. Parents and Carers will be required to send packed lunches for their children if they accrue arrears totalling **more than 2 weeks**. Copies of our school dinner money & charging polies are available on our website.



Cost of School Meals for Summer 1 Half Term will be:

£49.45 per child
