School Trips

All of our children have either taken part in or are planning to take part in trips during the final half term of the school year. The vast majority of our parents continue to support school making your contributions plans known to school. we would like to thank you for your continued support in enhancing children's respect and love of learning through a range of approaches, including trips and visits. Without your continued support, the children of Little Heaton CE would not be able to participate in these activities.

Little Heaton CE has arranged the option for parents to pay for school trips by paying fortnightly instalments via a payment plan to help spread the cost of these trips and many families have taken the opportunity to contribute in this way. We have also used support from our local PCC as a Church of England school to support two additional trips, linked to our RAF networks, to fund transport for Year 5 and Year 4 'Fairy God Mum Art Event' and the Year 4 Peace Service.

Unfortunately a minority of our parents across all classes have not contributed towards these trips and as a result, Little Heaton CE may have to consider cancelling future trips and refunding any money paid for trips that have not yet taken place if we do not receive sufficient support from all families to cover the cost of these activities.
