# English

This half term we will begin by learning to recite poems from the book *Commotion in the Ocean* by Giles Andreae. We will then write our own poems about a creature who lives in the sea. Our next unit will be learning to write a fantasy story, basing our work on *Billy's Bucket* by Kes Gray.

#### Maths

Our focus will be on multiplication and division and then fractions. All children we also be getting a log in for *Times Table Rock Stars* which they can use to practice their multiplication skills. Science Our focus will be on materials and their properties. We will learn to identify, compare and group common materials, investigating their properties.

## Homework

Children will have spellings to learn each week. They also have access to *Purple Mash* and *Times Table Rock Stars*. These sites offer a variety of fun games for your children to explore.

## **Reading Books**

Each week children will bring home two reading books. One that they will have been reading as part of their phonics lesson that week and another linked to their reading ability.
