Becoming a Little Heaton Ambassador

- Children can very quickly become a Little Heaton
 Ambassador in school by demonstrating our core values in school.
- Children earn stickers, certificates, medals and ultimately a trophy if they display consistent and significant evidence of all six values across the year.

We like to ask ourselves, 'What three things comes first?' We love to spot these things (love, respect and resilience) in school and talk about them and reward them. We recognise that the more we show them, the easier it is to see them in others.







We reflect all the time on our role within the community in our class and school. We talk about how we are part of a family and that we learn to show *love*, *trust* and *respect* for each other. We recognise that sometimes things might not go as planned them and at those times we need to learn to demonstrate *resilience* and *honesty*.
