English

This half term, the focus will be on transition work; the children will complete a piece of writing which will be sent to their new school to celebrate their writing achievements. We will be completing a range of writing tasks focusing on the books 'Clockwork' by Philip Pullman and 'Jamie' by L D Lapinski

Maths

Our focus will be on consolidating our skills and knowledge in all areas of maths. The children will complete various problem-solving activities and maths investigations

Science

Our focus will be on electricity where the children will build on their previous learning in Year 4 to build and represent different electrical circuits using a range of components.

Homework

Online spelling learning tasks will be set weekly via *Purple Mash*.

The children will be exploring the question, 'Is it better to express your religion in arts and architecture or through charity and generosity?' They will investigate different mosques and churches and consider the work of Christian Aid and Islamic Relief.

Topic

Our focus this half term is on Geography. The children will complete a field study of the locality, where they will gain an understanding of the links between map symbols and real places and identify and record significant local features. The children will have the opportunity to upload their photographs to the mapping website 'Geograph'.
