English

Writing: We will continue our writing linked to *The Disgusting Sandwich* by Gareth Edwards. Following creating our own version of the story we will learn how to write instructions for our own disgusting sandwich.

Maths

We will focus on numbers to 100 to begin the term. We will learn how to partition these numbers as well as comparing them and finding one more and one less. During this term we will also find out more about adding and subtracting money as well as how to tell the time.

Mental arithmetic is extremely important in maths to help free up children's brain capacity to answer more difficult reasoning questions. Please keep revising number bonds to 10 and 20 with your child as this will really help them in their addition and subtraction work.

Science

This term's focus is about the seasons. We will be talking about what each season is like, the differences between the seasons and how this effects the world around us.

Homework

Children will have spellings to learn each week. Please help them with these as it will help them with their writing activities

Reading Books:

We ask all parents to read with their child as often as possible and ask them questions about their reading. Reading is about comprehension and remembering information from books not just decoding words. We shall change reading books every Wednesday; please read own books in between these times or take free books from school that your child has access to.

Topic

This term in Geography we are using maps, atlases and photographs to find out about the countries in the UK. They will learn about the capital cities and the physical and human features of each of them. If you have any photographs of visits to different parts of the UK please can you send us them so that we can share them together.

This term we will be focussing on the story of the creation as told in the Bible, Genesis 1:1-2. We will consider what it feels like to create something special and all the things we should be thankful for in the world that God created.
