English

This half term our text will be the fiction story *Meerkat Mail* by Emily Gravett.

The children will be making a missing poster for Sunny to help his family try to find him. We will make sure to include lots of good vocabulary to describe him.

Our Non-fiction focus is writing a postcard.

Maths

Our focus this half term is: Doubling, Sharing & grouping, Even & odd, Spatial reasoning, Visualise and build, Deepening understanding, Patterns & relationships, Spatial mapping and mapping.

RE

Our RE topic is 'What makes a good friend?'

During this unit we will explore the meaning of friendship, how we make friends and why friends are important. We will know about Jesus making friends, how he made friends and who he chose

Topic

In topic the children will be learning about 'Journeys'

We will think about if we would like to live in a hot place like the Kalahari Desert. The children will be learning about where we live and looking at some similarities and differences between life in this country and life in other countries.

The children will be given the opportunity to use simple maps and atlases to help locate where we live.

Homework

Reading

Reading books are changed once a week in order to consolidate new vocabulary and give children the opportunity to fully comprehend what they have read and improve fluency.

Remember your child brings home 3 books a week. A book they can phonetically decode, a paper ditty book and a book they have selected themselves from the library. If you lose these books you will be charged.
