### English

This half term our focus will be on the book "Traction Man is Here" by Mini Grey. We will be exploring, interpreting and responding to this wonderful picture book as well as writing in role and writing letters.

### Maths

Our focus will be Multiplication and Division. We will be looking at recognising, making and adding equal groups, as well as learning and using the 2x, 5x and 10x tables.

### RE

We will be focussing on Easter signs and symbols with particular emphasis on the symbolism of the Paschal candle. We will be looking at a variety of crosses and making one.

### Science

Our focus will be *Living things and their habitats*. In this topic we will be exploring and comparing differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive. We will also be identifying that most living things live in habitats to which they are most suited.

### Homework


